ORDER

WHEREAS the appeal of Shri Jagadguru Siddeshwara Womens B.Ed. College, Bagaikot Karnataka dated 21/05/2007 is against the Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.ED./2006-2007/2104 dated 27/04/2007 of the Southern Regional Committee, refusing recognition for conducting B.Ed. course on the grounds that the building shown is under construction for the proposed course and the instructional facilities are inadequate as per NCTE norms

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Shri Jagadguru Siddeshwara Womens B.Ed. College (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 25/05/2007 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Shri Basavaraj Swamiji, the President and Shri Manohar H.A., the Member, Shri Jagadguru Siddeshwara Womens B.Ed. College, Bagalkot, Karnataka presented the case of the appellant institution on 03/09/2007. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that the building was already complete even much personal presentation and completion certificate dated 05/9/2005 obtained from the before inspection and completion certificate dated 05/9/2005 obtained from the Municipal authority to this effect was produced before the Council. It-was also clarified that the existing D.Ed course is being run in the ground floor and the proposed B.Ed course will be run in the first and the second floor of the building. Relevant documentary proof was submitted in support of the claim of having adequate instructional facilities as per NCTE Norms.

AND WHEREAS having considered the oral submission, the papers presented, the records of the case and the VT report, the Council felt that there was enough ground to accept this appeal. Accordingly the appeal was accepted for grant of recognition for B.Ed. Course and SRC's order dated 27/04/2007 was reversed with direction to SRC to grant recognition to the institution immediately.

After considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 14.03.2007, to the applicant institution under provisio to Section 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

Further, applicant institution had submitted the written representation on 09.04.2007. The said representation was considered by the Regional Committee on 132nd Meeting of SRC held on 18-19 April, 2007 and the Committee decided to refuse recognition.

accordingly, order of refusal was issued vide in No.2104 dated 27.04.2007.

The applicant institution preferred appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, before NCTE, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority considering the appeal passed an order . ce F No.89-65/2007 dated. 07.09.2007 reversing the decision of SRC.

The NCTE Headquaters Vide Letter dated 13.09.2007 directed this office to issue the recognition orders to the institution wherever reversal of decision is there and place the ceasion before SRC Subsequently. Accordingly, Conditional Recognition letter was subject to the institution on 18.09.2007. The institution has subjected reply with necessary annexures and staff approval from the Registrar, Karnataka State women's University, Bijapur, Karnataka

Hence the Order.

- AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE
- Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Sri Jagadguru Siddeswara Women's B.Ed College, Guiedgudda-587203, Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100(Hundred) students shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - iii) The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years premises) in case the course is started in rented
 - iv) The institution will ensure that Principal and Seven faculty members duly approved by the affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.
